### **Proposed changes to the signalised junction of Caledonian Road and Wharfdale Road**

Following the changes to the junction of Caledonian Road and Wharfdale Road in 2014 to address road safety concerns, the Council received complaints from residents regarding delays and queuing. As a result of these complaints the Council has agreed to return the junction to a layout similar to that prior to 2014.

The traffic lights will be converted to on-demand pedestrian crossings in Wharfdale Road and just north of the junction on Caledonian Road. Caledonian Road south of the junction will return to three lanes southbound and when the traffic signals are green Wharfdale Road and Caledonian Road southbound will run at the same time.

The southern crossing will be removed and cyclists travelling along Wharfdale Road will access Killick Street via a Toucan Crossing (across the northern arm). Killick St (east) will become one-way southbound from Caledonian Road to Southern Street. The new layout will result in the loss of two parking spaces on Killick Street between Caledonian Road and Southern Street.

We are intending to start the works on Saturday 17 September and it will take approximately four weeks to complete the work. Caledonian Road (north of the junction) will be closed on 17 and 18 September, and 24 and 25 September. Wharfdale Road will be closed on 1 and 2 October, and 8 and 9 October. Killick will become one way from 17 September in order to carry out the works.
